INCLUSIONS:

Lodging, all meals, and licenses are included for any fishing and wing shooting activities at Honey Lake Plantation. Skeet/trap/five stand warm ups, guides, dogs, eye and ear protection, transportation from Tallahassee Regional Airport, and on-property transportation. Guides may be hired for fishing on Honey Lake, Lake Ashley, and Lake Hooking Bull. Unguided fishing is allowed on Lake HaHaLaLa and Lake Oboe. Tackle is provided for guided fishing, and guests are allowed 6 birds per day per shooter.

EXCLUSIONS:

Shotgun rentals, shells, shooting apparel, tackle for unguided fishing, bird processing fees, Resort Service Fee gratuities, appropriate taxes and alcohol.

DEPOSIT/PAYMENT/ CANCELLATION/ GRATUITIES

Honey Lake Plantation requires a 50% deposit to secure your reservation, with the balance due 60 days prior to arrival. Deposits are non-refundable. That said, we understand that life sometimes throws us a curve ball, and provided that we receive notification of your cancellation in excess of 60-days of your arrival you may apply your deposit to a new booking within the same season. And to account for any unplanned events that may cause a complete cancellation we highly recommend trip insurance. Honey Lake Plantation accepts credit cards and traveler's checks. Appropriate sales taxes are additional.
